Dear Parent / Carer and Young Person,

Annual seasonal flu vaccination

All children and young people from reception to year 9 are being offered the flu vaccination in school by Leicestershire Partnership NHS Trust's Community Immunisation Service, as part of the national vaccination programme.

Flu can be an unpleasant illness and make some people seriously ill. The flu vaccination protects against seasonal flu (influenza) and will also help to prevent the spread of flu, helping to protect others who are vulnerable.

The vaccine is offered as a nasal spray or a gelatine-free injectable. To find out more about the vaccine visit: tiny.cc/fluvaccination or watch our animation: www.healthforkids.co.uk/staying-healthy/stopping-flu

We will only give your child the flu vaccination if we have your consent. Please do this as soon as possible, using the instructions below. You only need to submit your decision once.

How to give consent for your child to get the flu vaccination

- Make a note of the code for your school. For **Beaumont Lodge Primary School** the school code is **LE120087**
- Complete the online consent form by visiting: www.leicsandrutlandimms.co.uk or scan the QR code using your smartphone camera to go straight to the website.
- Select **Seasonal Flu** and enter the school code.
- On the consent declaration page you can consent for either the nasal flu vaccine **or** the gelatine-free injectable flu vaccine.
- You will receive a confirmation email when the form is submitted.

Your school will let you know when the vaccination session will take place. The consent system will close one working day before the session. You will not be able to submit a consent form on the day.

What flu vaccine is my child being offered?

My child has a health condition and normally has the vaccine from the GP.

My child is unable to have the nasal flu vaccine due to medical reasons.

Where can I read the vaccine product leaflet?

It says the email addresses don't match or it doesn't recognise the school code.

What if my child is absent or unwell on the session day?

What's the national vaccination programme?

The nasal flu vaccine is offered as a quick and painless spray up the nose. It is also offered as a gelatine-free injectable, as some children are unable to have this due to medical reasons or due to personal choice as it is gelatine free. It is important to know that the injection is less effective than the nasal flu vaccine.

They are also able to have the vaccination at the school.

Our team will review the medical information submitted and will discuss their eligibility and offer the injectable flu vaccine if required.
