Intent

At Beaumont Lodge Primary School we are HISTORIANS, whose understanding of the past leads an understanding of the present! We want to fuel our children's curiosity toward a love of history and to be inspired to become archivists, museum curators, archaeologists or research analysts. When investigating life in the past, children will gain a sense of chronological awareness, identity and cultural understanding based on historical heritage. Through exploring the actions of significant people and events of Britain's past and that of the wider world, we aim to empower children's understanding of how different human societies have arrived at where they are today.



Implementation

To support children to know more and remember more, we will review prior learning and establish links to new areas of study. In EYFS and KS1, History will look at significant events and people who have shaped society locally, nationally and globally. In KS2, UK history will be taught chronologically to allow children to confidently place each time period and to further develop and deepen understanding of the timespan between historical events. In order to enquire and investigate, children will be given opportunities, where possible, to study artefacts from which analysis, interpretation, and evaluation will inform the presentation of findings. We plan for effective use of educational visits and visitors, to enhance all pupils' learning experience through an enriched History curriculum.






