## Y4 Beacon Hill Trip - Thursday 29th June 2023.

As part of Year 4's 'Extreme Earth & Natural Disasters' Science & Geography learning, a trip to Beacon Hill Country Park is being planned for Thursday, 29th June, 2023, leaving by coach at 9.15am and returning by 2.30pm. This trip will allow children to experience locally and first-hand the site of an extinct volcano and the resulting geological formations. It will also enable children to develop their geography knowledge and skills and introduce a range of animal habitats, including native and non-native species to the area.

During our visit, children will walk from the bottom of the hill via the labyrinth to the summit, where a picnic lunch and some time in the upper play area will be enjoyed. After lunch and on our way back down the hill, we shall spend some time in the wooded natural den-building area.

The area is hilly and open, with some uneven ground. As a result, children will need:

- good walking shoes or trainers
- long trousers/tracksuit bottoms rather than shorts or skirts
- a waterproof coat with hood/hat in the event of rain
- a peaked cap or other suitable hat should the day be sunny and warm
- Sun block cream (should be applied before the trip, as accompanying adults are not able to apply this to children during the day)
- Please send your child into school with a plastic water bottle or two, depending on the
  weather & a packed lunch (children entitled to Free School Meals will be provided with a
  packed lunch)

The cost of the trip has been subsidised by the school to reduce the cost to £9.00 per child. Unfortunately, if the cost is not met, the trip will have to be cancelled.

We do not require you to complete the usual medical information form, but we must inform you that we will be using the information that we currently hold in school and it is your responsibility to inform the school of any changes i.e. telephone contact numbers.
